Materials - Compare and group materials based on whether they are solids, liquids and gases. Observe materials changing state when heated or cooled. Identify and name the parts of the water cycle.

History – The Romans

How the Roman control expanded across Europe. Examine why the Romans decided to invade Britain. Explore what changed and what aspects of life stayed the same under the Romans and for a period after they left. Explore aspects of the long term impact of the Roman Empire and their significance.

Music

We will be exploring timbre and texture. Children will explore how sounds are made and how they can be used either individually or in unison.

MFL

Children will look at the pronunciation of French letters. They will build on this to explore vegetables.

Art

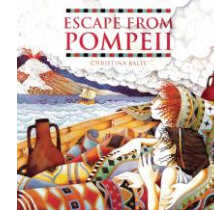
Children will design their own Roman mosaic. They will explore Roman mosaics and create repeating patterns before making their own using tiles and grout.
