### Science

Animals including humans - describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans, identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions, construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.

# History – The Romans

How the Roman control expanded across Europe. Examine why the Romans decided to invade Britain. Explore what changed and what aspects of life stayed the same under the Romans and for a period after they left. Explore aspects of the long term impact of the Roman Empire and their significance.

### Music

The children will be having weekly Listen2Me lessons. They will be exploring a variety of brass instruments.

### **MFL**

Children will look how to say and write the phrase Je voudrais (I would like) linked to ordering ice cream.

### **PSHE**

Safety First— children will explore how to keep themselves safe and understand peer pressure.
