An overview of PSHE in Year 2 – Spring Term 2

Our learning this term in PSHE will be about "respecting Rights".

Below you can read the overview of learning objectives for this PSHE topic.

What are Rights?

Children will discuss their understanding of rights before feeding back to the class. We will clarify our definition. Then children will be asked to think of three things with their partners which all human beings need.

Who protects our rights?

Children will take part in a discussion to think about how we protect our rights, who helps us and what we can do if we do not feel safe. They will learn who can help to protect our rights and how they might do this.

Respecting the rights of others

During this session, children will think about what the word 'respect' means. They will explore how they show respect to other people in their lives.

Respecting Differences

Children will think about what makes us different – exploring physical differences and understanding that we are all special. We will discuss how we should treat people who are different to us and how we can show respect despite any differences.

• Why is it important to be fair?

Children will explore a variety of scenarios and discuss whether they think the situations are fair or unfair – children will explore their ideas and discuss with each other. They will think about how it makes them feel when situations are not fair.

• Why is it important to make a difference?

Children will discuss which communities and groups they belong to? They will think about how we make a difference and spread positivity in these groups. as a class, we will think about our school community and how can we make a difference!
