An overview of PSHE in Year 5 - Spring Term 2

Our learning this term in PSHE will be learning about Britain. Below, you can read the overview of learning objectives for this PSHE topic.

• Identities

Children will talk about the range of faiths and ethnicities in Britain and identify ways of showing respect. They will understand that there are basic human rights shared by all people and all societies.



• Communities

Children will be able to explain what a community is and what it means to belong to one. They will learn that they have different kinds of responsibilities, rights and duties at home, at school, in the community and towards the environment.

• Respecting the Law

Children will explain why and how laws are made and identify what might happen if laws are broken. They will learn what democracy is, and about the basic institutions that support it locally and nationally.

Local Government

Children will discuss the terms of democracy and human rights in relation to local government.

National Government

Children will discuss the terms democracy and human rights in relation to national government.

• Making a Difference

Children will investigate what charities and voluntary groups do and how they support the community. They will think about the lives of people living in other places, and people with different values and customs.
