

An overview of PSHE in Year 2 – Summer Term 1

Our learning this term in PSHE will be about living in the wider world and the idea of “One World.” Below you can read the overview of learning objectives for this PSHE topic.

- **Families**
Children will learn more about the differences and similarities in families and what it means to be a family. We will explore family life in different countries and compare this to our own experiences.
- **Homes**
Children will continue learning to respect the differences and similarities between people. We will discuss our homes and home life and compare our experiences to those of others around the world. We will reflect on what we are grateful for in our homes.
- **Schools**
We will build on our prior learning of rights and respect to reflect on our experiences at school. We will learn more about what it is like to go to school in different places around the world and compare the differences and similarities.
- **Environments**
Children will use prior learning of rights and respect as well as learning covered in this unit to help them reflect on the different places in which people live, work and learn. We will compare different ways of living around the world and reflect on our own experiences.
- **Resources**
We will learn more about our local environment and what could help or harm the environment. We will learn about how people around the world use the Earth’s resources and how this can sometimes be harmful to the planet.
- **Planet Protectors**
Children will learn about why it is important to take care of the Earth and will find out about things they could do to help. Children will take on the role of planet protector!
