

## Science

### Rocks and Fossils

Children will explore and learn more about different types of rocks and how they are formed. They will begin to identify and describe them based on their properties. -

Children will learn about the process of fossilisation and how humans extract found fossils. They will find out more about the properties of soils.



### Geography

**Coasts:** Children will learn to describe geographical features of coasts. They will begin to explain the differences between natural and man-made geographical features and will identify these. Children will continue to develop their skills when reading maps and atlases.

### Music

**Texture and pitch:** Children will listen and respond to music from other cultures and will begin to imitate then compose their own music. Children will learn to play a pentatonic scale on a tuned instrument.

### Art

**Printmaking and Textiles:** Children will learn about the printmaker Angie Lewin. They will learn more about print-making and how printing tools and blocks can be made to create patterns. They will use a block they have made to print their own coastal bag design.



### PSHE

**It's My Body:** Children will find out more about how to keep their bodies safe and healthy. They will learn about the importance of hygiene, sleep and how to respect their bodies. They will study the text, *Your Body is Awesome!*

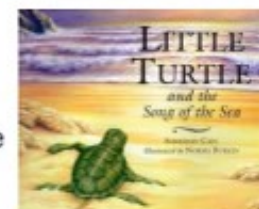
**Gospel:** In this topic of work about Christianity children will learn more about the role of disciples. They will learn Bible stories about disciples and learn more about parables.
