

## Science

**Everyday Materials:** Children will learn about the uses of different everyday materials and their suitability for different purposes, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rocks and papers. Children will experiment with changing the form of materials by bending, squashing, twisting and stretching them.

## History

Children will learn about the Great Fire of London and how this changed life in 1666. We will learn about the impact of the fire, how it started and how the people of London tried to put it out. Children will compare life in 1666 to life now and think about how we put out fires in modern Britain.

## English

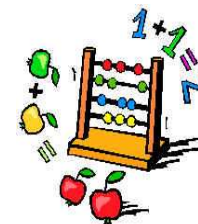
Children will continue to consolidate their use of phonics to help them read and write.
