An overview of PSHE in Year 3 - Autumn Term 1

Our learning this term in PSHE will be about successful teamwork skills and their individual responsibilities when working in a team.

Below you can read the overview of learning for this PSHE topic.



A New Start

Children will discuss changes and how they might make them feel. They will deepen their understanding of good and not so good feelings, to extend their vocabulary to enable them to explain both the range and intensity of their feelings to others.

• Together Everyone Achieves More

Children will discuss and explain how and why they should work well as a team. They will begin to understand that their actions affect themselves and others and work collaboratively towards shared goals.

Working Together

The children will discuss how their actions and behaviour affects their team. They will work collaboratively towards shared goals.

Being Considerate

Children will learn the skill of paying attention and responding considerately to others. They will develop strategies to resolve disputes and conflict through negotiation and appropriate compromise and to give rich and constructive feedback and support to benefit others as well as themselves.

• When Things Go Wrong

Children will discuss why disputes might happen and strategies to resolve them. They will explore resolving differences by looking at alternatives, seeing and respecting others' points of view, making decisions and explaining choices.

Responsibilities

Children will understand that their actions affect themselves and others. They will work collaboratively towards shared goals and learn that they have different kinds of responsibilities, rights and duties at home, at school, in the community and towards the environment.
