

An overview of PSHE in Year 5 - Autumn Term 1

Our learning this term in PSHE will be about TEAM (Together Everyone Achieves More). Below, you can read the overview of learning objectives for this PSHE topic.



- **Together Everyone Achieves More**

Children will understand that their actions affect themselves and others. They will learn how to work collaboratively towards a shared goal. They will share and discuss the attributes of a good team and apply them to our class.

- **Communicate**

Children will learn to listen and respond respectfully to a wide range of people. They will feel confident to raise ideas and concerns within a group and recognise it can be necessary to succeed in a task.

- **Collaborate**

Children will work collaboratively in this session to achieve a shared goal. This will involve them using the skills we have covered previously. How they share and communicate will be key in this session.

- **Compromise**

Children will learn to face a new challenge positively by collecting information, looking for help and taking action. They will continue to develop their collaborative skills to seek an alternative solution in order to ensure a task is completed.

- **Care**

Children will continue to listen and respond respectfully to each other within the session. They will reflect on the need to care for individuals within a team as well as the team as a whole.

- **Shared Responsibilities**

Children will understand the importance of shared responsibilities in helping a team to function successfully. They will learn the different kinds of responsibilities, rights and duties they have at home, school and in the community. This will be achieved through children drawing on their experiences throughout this module of learning.

Our story focus this half term is Stone Soup - a picture book all about cooperation and team work.
