



An overview of PSHE in Year 1 – Autumn Term 2

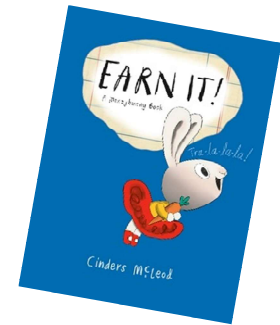
Our learning this term in PSHE will be 'Money Matters'. Children will learn about what money is, where it comes from and how we can make good decisions about spending or saving our money.

What is money?

Children will learn about what money is and the different form money can come in. We will be exploring all the different things we need money for.

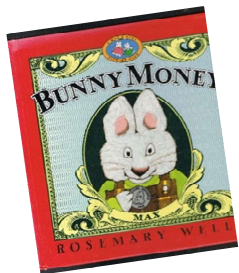
Where does it come from?

We will read "Earn it" written by Cinders McLeod to think about where money comes from and the different ways we can earn money.



Why should we look after it?

The children will learn about the role that money plays in their lives and how to keep it safe.

We will also be thinking about our choices whether we spend or save money. We will use the story "Bunny Money" written by Rosemary Wells to discuss when is a good time to spend money and when is a good time to save money.

We will continue to read the story "Bunny Money" to explore when we want something or need something. We will look at and discuss different adverts and how they try to influence our spending and why they do this.
