An overview of PSHE in Year 2 - Spring 1

Our learning this term in PSHE will be about respecting rights. Children will explore the concepts of difference and fairness and encourages them to reflect on how we should behave towards those who are different from us and why it is important to be fair. We will be using the story 'Speak Up' during this topic.

SPEAK UP! YOU dan note of dan

• Rights.

Children will find out more about what are rights and identify rights that all people share. We will talk about kind and unkind behaviour and how this can affects others. We will recognise the ways in which we are the same and different to others.

• Protecting our Rights.

Children will talk about risk in simple everyday situations and what action to take to minimise harm. We will talk about and share opinions on things which matter to them. We will talk about who protects our rights.

Respecting others.

We will learn about how to respond if physical contact makes them feel uncomfortable or unsafe. We will talk about about what is kind and unkind behaviour and how this can affect others. Children will understand how people and other living things have different needs and about the responsibilities of caring for them. Children will talk about how they can show respect for the rights of others and understand why this is important.

• Everybody's different.

Children will recognise the ways they are the same as, and different to, other people. We will discuss how they can show respect for the differences between people.

Is it Fair?

We will learn about how to talk about and share their opinions on things that matter to them. We will recap on how people and other living things have different needs and about the responsibilities of caring for them. Children will understand why it is important to be fair and what this means.

• Taking Part.

Children will discuss things they can do to help look after their environment Children will talk about the different groups they belong to. We will listen to ways in which other people play and work cooperatively. Children will explain why making a positive difference is important.
