

## History

We will be continuing our focus on Ancient Egypt. Children will be learning more about life in Ancient Egypt and comparing it to life now as well as what England would have been like at the time.

## Music

In music, our topic focus will be 'Chinese Lanterns'. Children will learn to play the Chinese Lanterns song on tuned percussion instruments with a focus on pitch and texture. Children will then perform their own songs with the Chinese Lanterns patterns.
