

### Science - Habitats



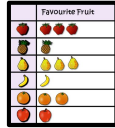
Learning will focus on how animals and plants live in a variety of different places called habitats. They will investigate how animals have adapted to survive in different habitats.



We will continue to learn about seasonal change and identify how plants and animals respond to changes in weather and day length.

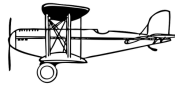
### Computing - Data

The children will collect their own data from the class and will use this data to create simple pictograms.



### DT - Bi-planes

They will design and make bi-planes using cardboard cardboard tubes as the base of their planes. They will then evaluate their final product and decide if they would do anything differently.



### Music - Pitch - The 3 Bears

They will perform songs and chants about the 3 bears. They will identify low, middle and high sounds played on chime bars and will then play their own tuned instruments.



### History - Flight

They will learn about the history of flight including the lives and achievements of the Wright brothers and Amelia Earhart.

### RE - Salvation and New Life

The children will think about why Easter is important to Christians. They will learn that Easter is a festival that occurs in spring to remember a very important part of the Bible. The Easter story is one of sadness, followed by great happiness.



### PE - Gym

They will use the wall bars, benches and vaults to move safely on, over and through. They will travel in different ways and develop simple sequences of movements.

### PE - Multi-skills

The children will use rackets, bean bags and balls to develop balancing, sending and receiving skills.



### English

This term's author in focus is Kate Pankhurst. We will read and enjoy exploring some of her books about Great Women.



In our English lessons we will be reading Emma Jane's Aeroplane, The Super Silly Museum and The Great Paper Caper. We will learn to identify verbs and will focus on spelling past tense using the suffix ed. The children will continue to use and as a joining word within sentences.

### Maths



The children will learn the features of simple 2D shapes. They will start learning about simple fractions as they find half and quarter of shapes. They will count in multiples of 2 and multiples of 10 and they will solve simple multiplication and division problems.

### PSHE - Britain

They will learn that they are part of a school community and wider community, how to be a good neighbour and how to look after their environment. They will learn about Britain as a community and recognise the similarities and differences within the community.
